TarraWarra Museum of Art is located at 313 Healesville-Yarra Glen Rd, Healesville VIC 3777 in the beautiful Yarra Valley region.

BY CAR

One hour's drive north-east of Melbourne and a five minute drive from the regional hub of Healesville. Free car parking available on-site.

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

From Melbourne, catch the train to Lilydale Station then join connecting bus route 685 (Lilydale-Healesville). Visit ptv.vic.gov.au for timetables and further details.

ARCHIBALD PRIZE 2019

TarraWarra Museum of Art is the exclusive Victorian tour venue for the *Archibald Prize 2019*, Australia's oldest and most prestigious art award, from 14 September – 5 November.

Presented by the Art Gallery of New South Wales and ANZ, the annual portrait exhibition provides a snapshot of Australian culture –

from politicians and celebrities to sporting heroes and authors. Since its inception in 1921, the prize has been awarded to some of Australia's most important artists, often inciting controversy while chronicling the changing face of Australian society and evolving definitions of portraiture.

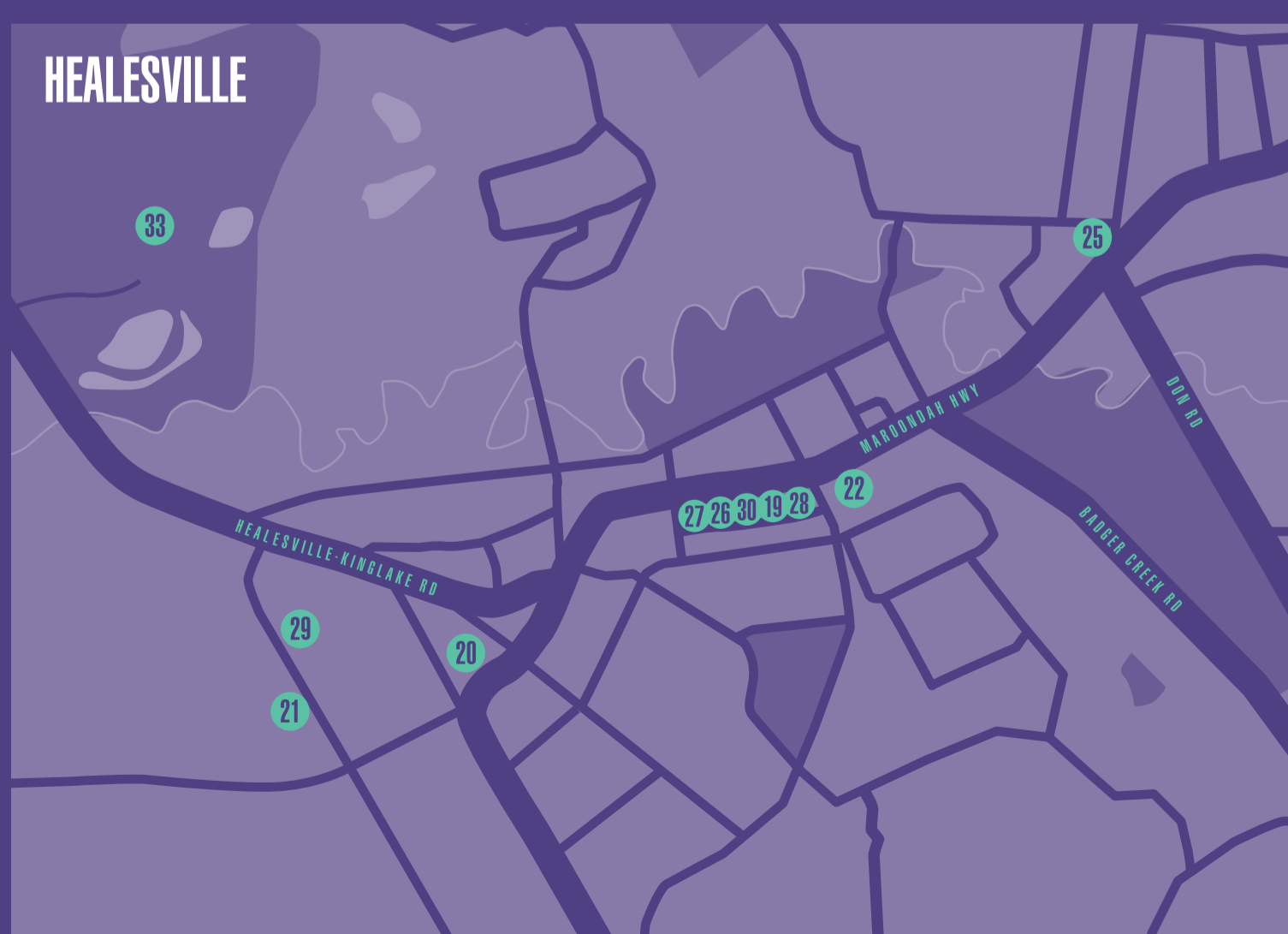
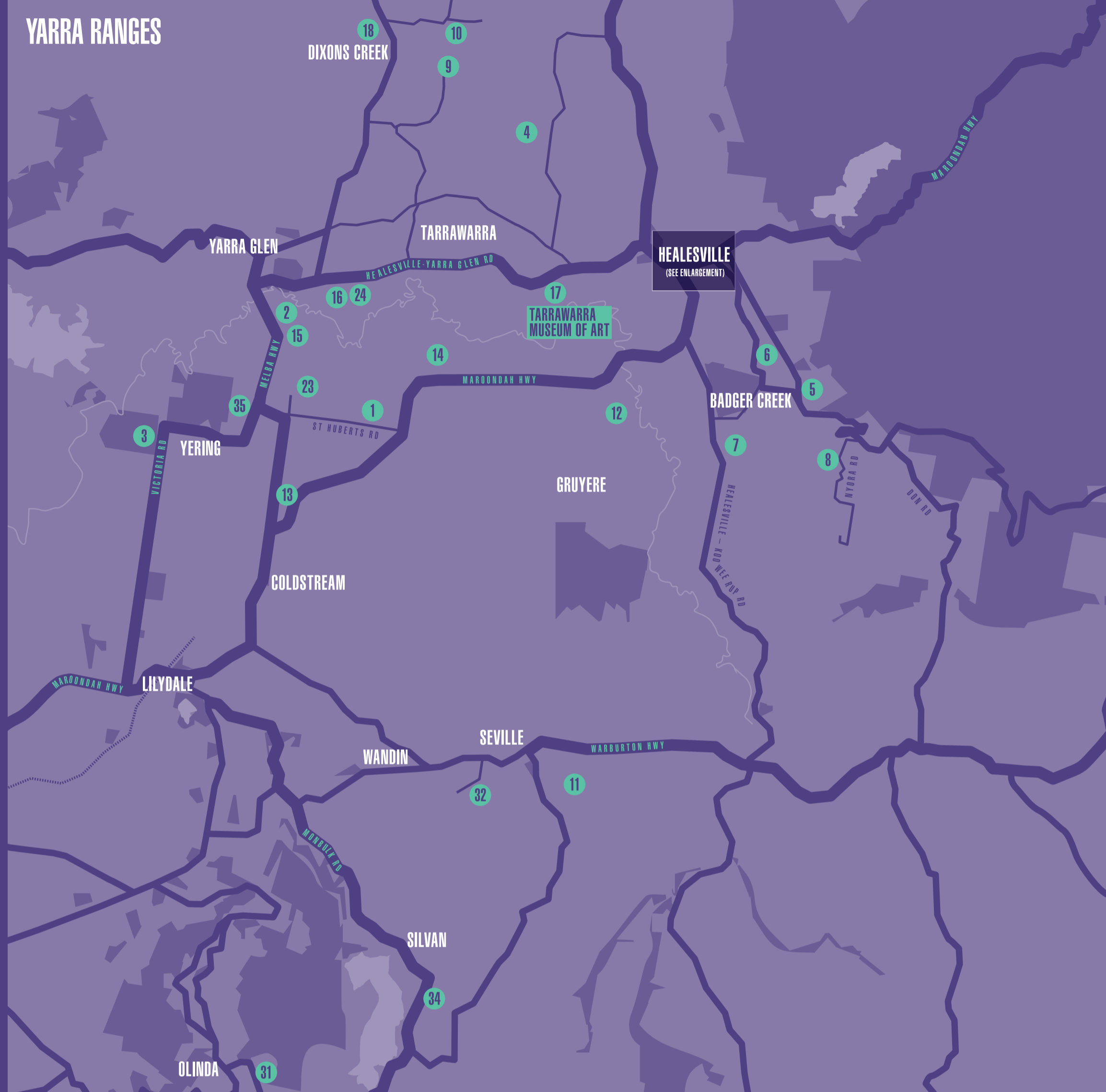
