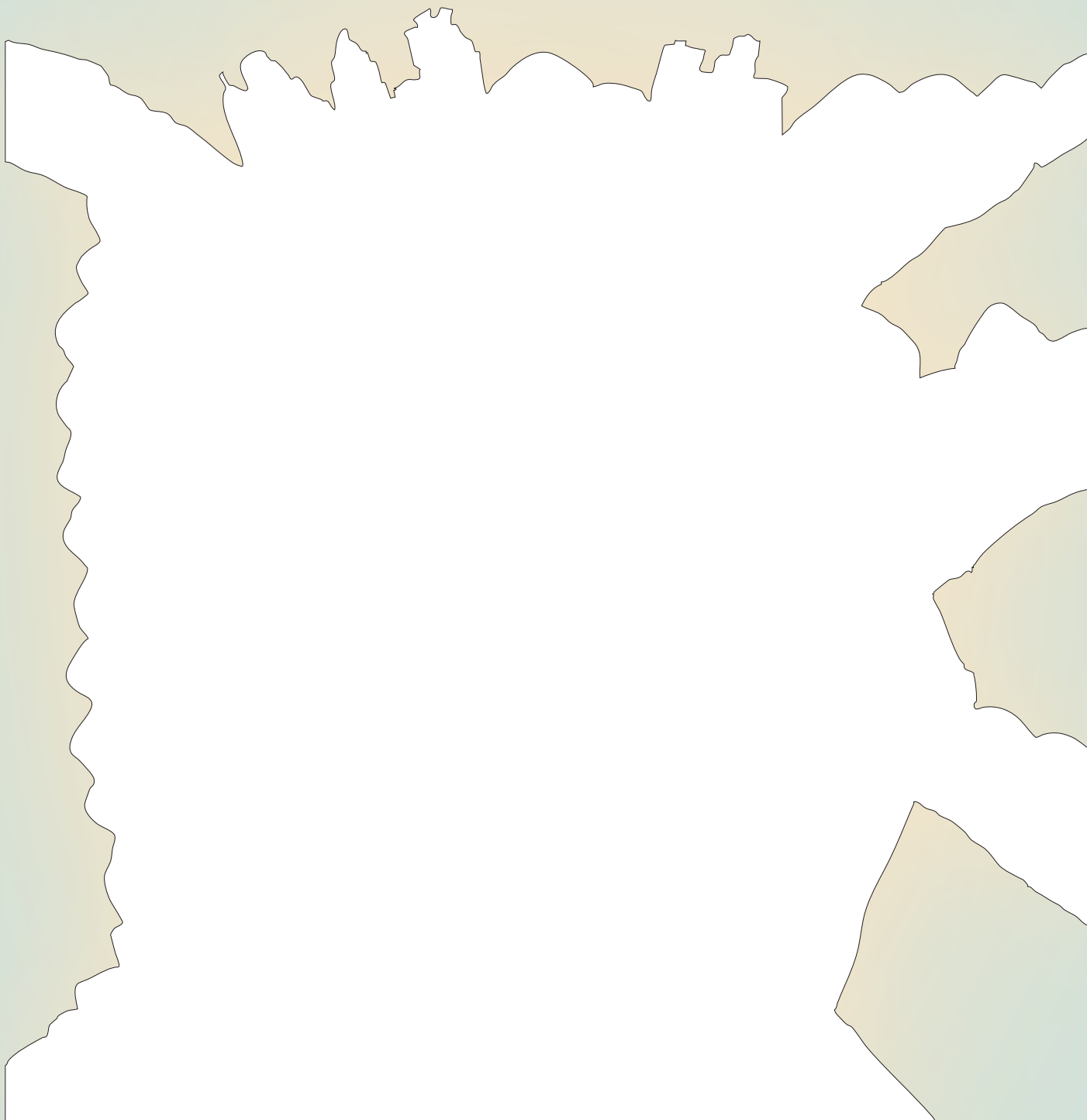
In **Scene 8: Dreams**, find a painting about magic titled *La Sarta (The Dressmaker)* 2001. Draw the hat worn by the person in this painting.
